FootGolf Basic Rules

- Make sure you are able to identify your ball;
- The ball must be played in a single movement (it is not allowed to touch, tap or roll the ball with the bottom of your foot);
- Wait until the ball has completely come to rest before playing;
- Kick off your ball from the FootGolf marked tee markers;
- The player farthest from the hole is the first to kick the ball;
- If the ball lands in a hazard (golf greens are considered a hazard) you receive one penalty shot and you must drop the ball within 2 steps from the closest clear land point from where the ball entered the hazard, or place the ball at the position of the previous kick;
- If your ball lands in a bunker, you are required to rake the bunker after you have kicked the ball out of the sand;
- Keep up with the group in front of you;
- Show consideration for other players and golfers at all times;
- Remember to shake hands with your fellow Footgolfer after you finish your round!
- **SOCCER BOOTS WITH STUDS OR SPIKES ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE COURSE – sneakers or indoor/turf boots are ok.**
